This is the second year that student residents of Loudoun County, Grades 9-12, are eligible for one of two grants awarded on the basis of their leadership in the area of interfaith activities. Two grants of \$750 will be presented at the Interfaith Day of Thanks on Sunday, November 7, 2010, at the Northern Virginia Baha'i Center in Sterling, Virginia.

Award recipients will be selected based the student's involvement in a community service activity that fosters interfaith or multicultural understanding. Letters of recommendation and other documentation which supports their involvement must be provided along with the application.
